

Exchange on Curricula project meeting

Wednesday, December 4, 2024, from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m., in the ESA (Ecole Supérieure d'Agronomie) conference room. The objective of this meeting is to take stock of the activities on the



curriculum of the Master of Conservation and Transformation of Agricultural Products and the organization of the dissemination workshop.

1. Update on the Masters curricula

Brief presentation of the CHAIN project. CHAIN is a project on food value chains funded by the European Union in partnership with the German University [Weißenstephan-Triesdorf](#). This is an experiment carried out within this university; where the idea is that agricultural and food higher education works must start from the base; and which finds at some point to extend it to African countries. These are: Germany, Nigeria, Kenya, Ethiopia, Senegal and Togo. A number of projects are open there, particularly with regard to Togo with these other countries, the opening of a master's degree on the processing and preservation of agricultural products. The project will also create both an intra and inter-state organization network on agricultural value chains. CHAIN's activities are documented in WP work packages (W1 to W6). The roles of the steering team are recalled during this meeting.

2. Preparation of the dissemination workshop

“Dissemination package” is an activity planned in “CHAIN”. This workshop will take place as an information session before December 23. The University of Lomé is supposed to write a digital document of Newsletters merging those that the other university institutions of CHAIN will send. The media will be invited. The probable time of the event is from 9 am to 12 pm, between December 16 and 23. On the agenda, there will be: the presentation of the project, the responsible institutions, the master. There will also be testimonies from students who have already benefited from training experience of the Master model currently being prepared. The communication should be prepared to attract student invitations.
